Many drugs must be tested for auditory safety prior to going to market. Certain medications can damage the ear, resulting in hearing loss, ringing in the ears, or balance disorders. These drugs are considered ototoxic.

To adequately evaluate these types of drugs, auditory safety testing is done to identify potential risks.



Drugs intended to treat the ear and those known classes of risk should undergo functional auditory testing.

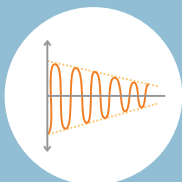
